

Dear Church Family,

The reason we keep coming back to it is because worship is vitally important to Christians. The scriptures teach us to worship. Jesus taught His followers to worship. The early church worshiped. Christians for the 2000 years since Jesus have always worshiped. And worship is a major part of what we will do for all eternity. Sounds pretty important doesn't it.

Here is one more reason why worship is important - it is the first step in our process for making mature reproducing followers of Christ. We believe that God is calling us as a people to catalyze life transformation in our community. There is only one path to this kind of life change and that is through committed discipleship. We are going there. We are serious about it. We will only get there when we commit ourselves to our weekly dynamic corporate encounter with the living majestic God.

We will gather this Sunday morning at 10:30 (with Sunday School before that). I will miss it due to my family visit in North Carolina. But I am excited to see you on February 27. Now that will be a day!
