We worked hard to send a large number of kids this year. Several of the children from the Christian School joined us. And glory to God, five of these children made professions of faith! God is at work, and it is a joy to see. In a week and a half our youth will go off to M-Fuge which is their annual mission trip. I know you are praying now for our youth that they too will have a great encounter with God. (Every life in Jasper transformed by Christ. . .!)

I can hardly wait. . .


