I've Been Thinking...

Dear Church Family,

Summers can be hard times in the annual rhythms of a church. Lots of people are out for vacation and the summer heat makes church participation difficult for some. The pace of church during the summer is different too. VBS works us to the max. Then we send off our kids to camp and our youth on mission (Mfuge in Fort Worth). Some of our children’s programing goes into high gear too. We are thankful for all that Allison is doing with our kids. The long and the short of all this is that it’s hard to build cohesion around what we are moving into because the present is a such a blur!

But we are on the move. For the first half of the year, I built a biblical case on Sunday mornings for the strategy we are moving into. Now we are studying the first chapter of the Sermon on the Mount to help us firm up what this Christian life looks like when it is lived out. I know many of you are in and out, but it is important that you stay connected to what we are doing as a congregation. Looking closely at the Beatitudes in Matthew 5 has helped us to reframe the Christ life from beginning to end. Our worship/study is not just to fill up the Sunday morning hour. It is to move us forward into Christlikeness.

Our activities and our studies in worship are all getting us prepared for where we are seeking to go this Fall. Soon you will receive the letter from the missions committee asking for ideas on how we can use the \$150,000 to help us be on mission with Christ. This is helping us live into the third step of our strategy. And this Fall we plan to begin (likely with a small step) Small Group home Bible studies. It is by sharing life (in koinonia) that we will see our greatest spiritual growth as individuals. The second step in our strategy is all about shared life and Small Groups will help us get there.

So you see – much is done – much is coming. Don’t miss out. God has great things for all of us.
