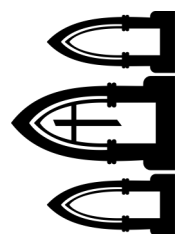

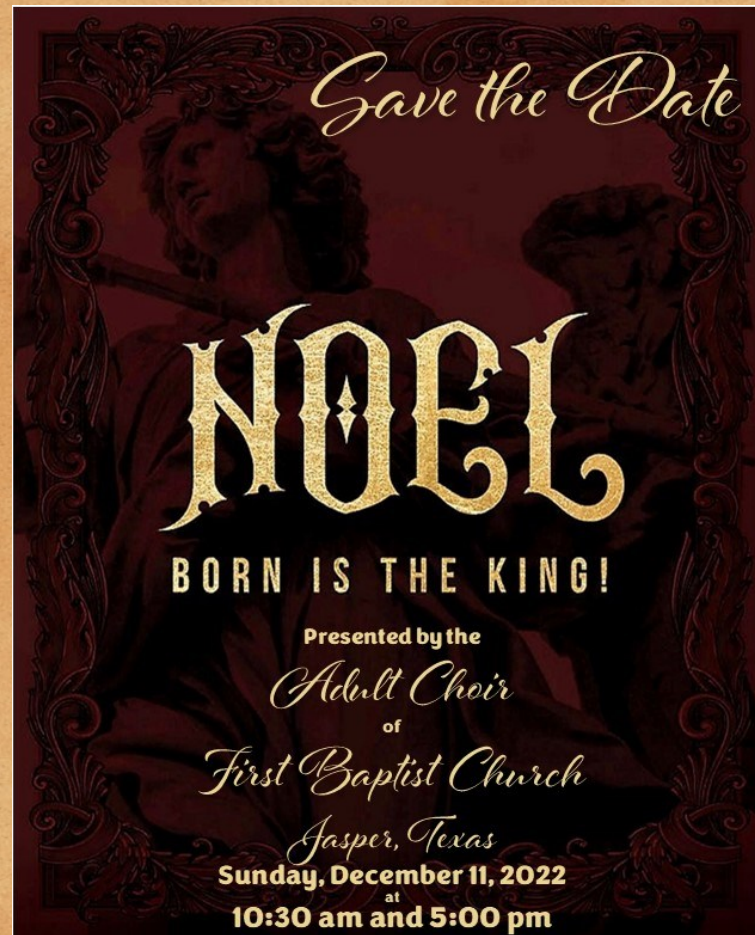
Rejoice dear brothers and sisters, for "though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me. . ."

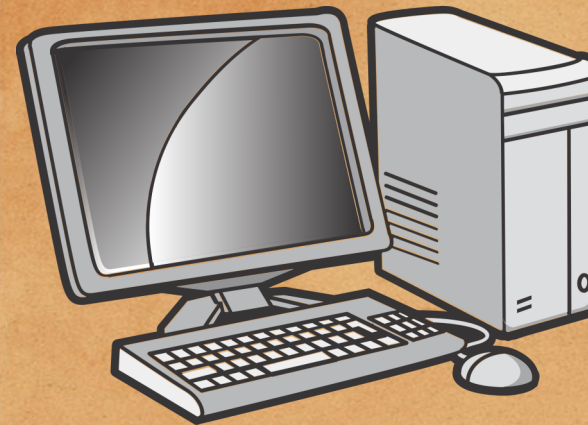
