I've Been Thinking...

Dear Church Family,

Sunday afternoon I will be flying to Tampa, Florida to attend the Southern Baptist Conference of the Deaf (SBCD). This is a conference I have attended every year since 1976. I am very grateful that the church allows me to attend this conference every year.

Those of you who do not know my background might wonder why I would attend a Deaf conference. Well, when I was a 13 year old boy I was attending an RA (Royal Ambassadors) boys camp just outside of Corpus Christi, Texas. Our camp director had a Deaf daughter and one day during the weeklong camp he brought his daughter out to our camp. Our director's wife spoke in chapel about Deaf ministry and then the daughter stood before all of us boys and signed the Lord's Prayer. It was beautiful and it touched my heart in a very deep place. At the end of that summer I started learning Sign Language and two years later I started interpreting in church for the Deaf people of Morgan Ave. Baptist Church in Corpus.

That was the start of my life in the Deaf world. When I graduated from seminary a group of Deaf people in New Orleans were seeking to start a new "Deaf" church. They called me to be their pastor. I pastored in New Orleans for almost 12 years and then went to Memphis where I pastored a Deaf church for almost 10 years. From there Irma and I went to North Carolina where I worked on the denominational level helping Baptist churches reach Deaf people for Christ.


So, you can see that my story is a "Deaf world" story. It might seem strange but almost everything I know about leading a church I learned in a Deaf church setting. I believe that God has used all those experiences to prepare me to be your pastor. He prepared me to love you, to learn from you, and to serve WITH you and not FOR you. I can't see far down the road from here, but I know it will be good and I know we will go there TOGETHER!


