



I've Been Thinking...

Dear Church Family,

In hope you have been following our journey through the book of Acts. We are not quite finished, but we are drawing near the end; my plan is to go through chapter 15. This Sunday we are in chapter 13. Before Jim left for his mission training, he preached from chapter 13. It was exciting to hear how he connected his own mission calling to the mission calling we see in chapter 13. Even though Jim preached from this chapter, I plan to hit it again this Sunday.

Chapter 13 marks a major turn. Up to this point the Acts story connected mostly to the Apostles and the Jerusalem church. Starting in chapter 13, the focus shifts to the life and ministry of Paul. From this point on, Luke, the writer of Acts, follows the career of Paul on his three missionary journeys and on his catastrophic trip to Rome. But all this started with the mission call that Paul and others experienced while serving in the church at Antioch.

We have learned about church life in each step of the Acts narrative. Every story has reminded us of our own church story. In our church we know that we have a mission from Christ, and we know that we have the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. We also know that God has given us a message to share with our community and the world and we have learned that hard knocks along the way shape us. I believe further that we have learned that God expects us (all of us) to make disciples. I hope you learned last Sunday that there is a cost we must pay if we will be His disciples, disciples who make disciples. Maybe you have even decided to pay that cost. I hope so.

I hope you will join us Sunday as we make this turn down the back side of Acts. We won't go but a few chapters into the missionary tales because our plan has been to learn from the life of the early church not the career of Paul. But there is more adventure that awaits us and there is more personal and individual life lessons that we will learn. I plan to see you Sunday.

I can hardly wait . . .
