The event was sponsored by the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and supported by many churches and individuals across our region. Many of you were able to go and I am so glad that you did. We were all able to see a great movement of God in the stadium as students and others responded to the invitation to commit their lives to Christ. When it was all said and done, 89 professions of faith decisions were recorded and countless decisions to be a more committed follower of Christ were made.
